Directions From North of Baltimore:

Take: I-695 E / Baltimore Beltway Inner Loop Take the Merritt Blvd.- Exit 39- toward Dundalk -0.2 miles. Merge onto Merritt Blvd. via the ramp on the left- 2.2 miles. Turn Right onto Merritt Ave. -0.1 miles. Merritt Ave. becomes Sollers Point Rd. -0.1 miles. Turn Right into Community College, drive around to the back.

Directions From South of Baltimore:

Take: I-95 N via Exit 11A toward Baltimore (Portions toll).- 9.6 miles. Take the Dundalk Ave exit- Exit 58. -0.3 miles. Turn Slight Right onto Dundalk Ave. -0.8 miles. Turn Left onto Holabird Ave. -0.1 miles Turn Right onto Sollers Point Rd.- 0.7 miles. Turn Right to stay on Sollers Point Rd. -0.2 miles. Turn Left into Community College, drive around to the back.
